## IIA CC K G SUKUMARAN STUDENT ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP



The Indian Institute of Architects- Cochin Centre, as part of its outreach program, is intending to provide scholarships to students undergoing a B Arch degree program in the institutions coming under its purview. The intent of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to students from economically weak backgrounds who are academically meritorious. The scholarship shall be awarded to a deserving student each from the oncoming 3rd and 5th academic year of the program, across the institutions.

The applications in the prescribed format duly endorsed by the Head of Institution shall be forwarded to the IIA Cochin Centre during the present semester and the award of scholarships shall be done with the commencement of the next semester.

## Eligibility:

1. Applicant shall be a student of the 4th semester or 8th semester of the B Arch degree program in one of the following institutions during the academic year 2020-21

- a. APJ Abdul Kalam School of Architecture, Muvatupuzha
- b. Asian School of Architecture and Design Innovation (ASADI), Cochin
- c. Holy Crescent College of Architecture, S.Vazhakkulam
- d. KMEA College of Architecture, Aluva
- e. School of Architecture, Mookambika Technical Campus, Muvatupuzha
- f. SCMS School of Architecture, Karukutty

2. Annual income of the family of the applicant shall be less than Rs.2 lakhs. Sufficient proof in the form of Income certificate from the Village office shall be submitted along with the application.

#### Scholarship:

A sum of Rs.50,000 shall be awarded to 2 students each from the 3rd year (5th semester) and the 5th year (9th semester) of the degree program in the academic year 2021-22.(4 students in total will benefit under this scheme)

#### How to apply?

Students are required to submit applications in the prescribed format during the application time window along with the following self-attested documents. The format shall be supplied to the participating colleges as well as available in the IIA Cochin Centre website.

The Head of Institution of each participant institution shall forward 4 applications (2 no:s from 3rd year and 5th year each) from the respective institution, along with the following attachments, as hard copies or soft copies.

- a. Copy of University mark sheets available till date.
- b. Design Portfolio certified by the Head of Institution (A4/A3 size)
- c. Income certificate from the Village office

Originals of the submission shall be produced for verification on demand.

#### Stages & Key dates:

Stage 1: 4th sem & 8th sem- Call for Scholarship - 17th June 2021

Stage 2: Submission of scholarship applications to the Scholarship committee from respective colleges - 16th July 2021

Stage 3: Short-listing of applications and scholarship awarding - 16th August 2021

Stage 4: 5th sem & 9th sem - Disbursement of scholarship - at the start of the semester

#### Criteria

The criteria for the award as well as decisions on the scholarship awardees shall be the sole discretion of the Scholarship committee constituted by the IIA Cochin Centre EC.

The committee shall have the right to enquire into the background of the applicants to ascertain facts as required.

## Scholarship committee

Scholarship committee shall consist of Chairman, Treasurer, an EC member, a Sponsor representative and a senior Architect with +25 years of experience. The committee shall be free to consult and obtain any advice on academic, financial matters etc. as required.
