




- 9. In event of a tie the last 9,6,3 and last hole will decide the winners and runner up prizes. If the tie continues the last 6,3 and last hole of the first nine will be applied. If the tie continues, joint Winners / RunnerUp will be declared.
- 10. The decisions on winners/scores/disputes and violations shall be decided by Tournament in-Charge Shyam Sunder and will be final.
- 11. The decision of the tournament committee will be final on all matters.
